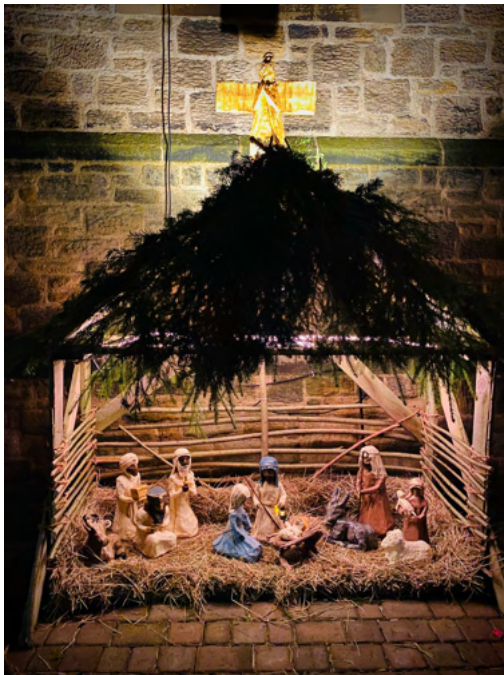




ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST NEWS

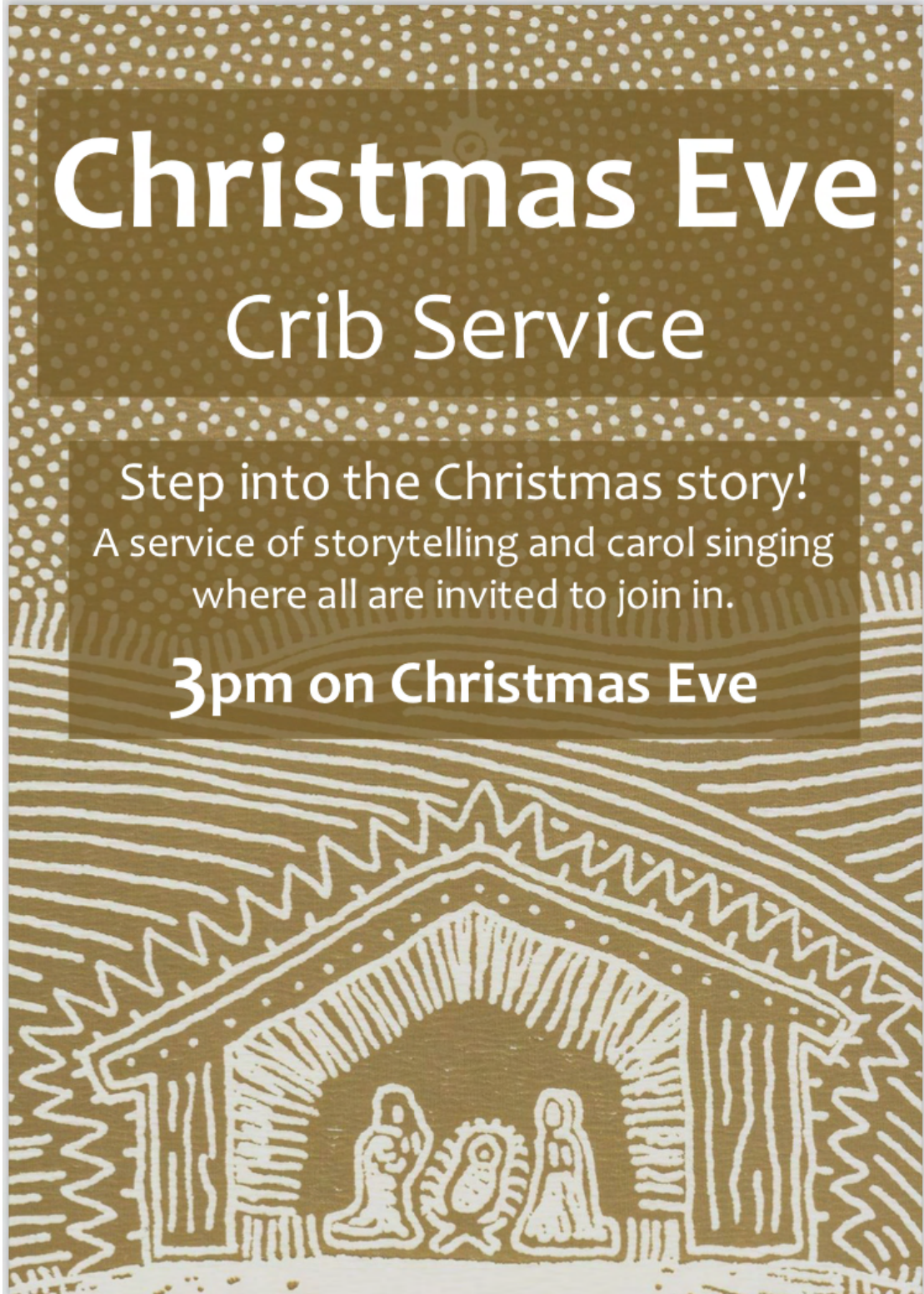
